The Committee acted to approve the request for the new location.

At the time of approval the address for the new location was: 6201 San Ignacio Avenue, San Jose, CA 95119. Prior to opening, the new location for the San Jose campus changed to: 5883 Rue Ferrari, San Jose, CA 95138.
