Retention Rates

The retention rate cohort consists of first-time, full-time degree seeking students who began their program of study in Fall 2022 (August 1, 2022 – October 31, 2023) and are still enrolled or who have completed their studies as of the end of Fall 2022 is **67%**.

The institutional and campus retention rates were calculated using the IPEDS formula.
