Retention Rates

The retention rate cohort consists of first-time, full-time degree-seeking students who began their program of study in Fall 2023 (August 1, 2023 – October 31, 2023) and are still enrolled or who have completed their studies as of the end of Fall 2024.

The institutional and campus retention rates were calculated using the IPEDS formula.
