Associate Degree in Nursing - Associate (Science Emphasis)

Graduates earn an Associate of Science degree. Graduates are prepared to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN)*. This program is only available for applicants in AZ, NV, NM, & OR

Dental Assisting – Certificate

Within the State of California, graduates are eligible to sit for the Registered Dental Assisting (RDA) exam offered by the Dental Board of California (DBC)* and apply to be a Registered Dental Assistant (RDA). This program is only available for applicants in AZ, CA, ID, NV, NM, OR & WA

Dental Assisting - Associate (Science Emphasis)

Graduates earn an Associate of Science degree. This program is only available for applicants in CA.

Dental Hygiene - Associate (Science Emphasis)

Graduates earn an Associate of Science degree. Graduates of the program are prepared to take the National Board Dental Hygiene Examination (NBDHE), as well as state or regional clinical licensing examinations*. This program is only available for applicants in AZ, CA, & ID

Diagnostic Medical Sonography - Associate

Graduates earn an Associate of Science degree. Students who successfully complete the Diagnostic Medical Sonography program are eligible to take the exams required to gain certification through the American Registry for Diagnostic Medical Sonography® (ARDMS). * This program is only available for applicants in CA.

Electrical Technology – Certificate

Graduates earn a Certificate of Completion. The Electrical Technology certificate program in California meets the standards set by the California Department of Industrial Relations for the current California Electrician Certification Program and prepares students to take the California General Electrician's Certification Exam administered by the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR).*

This program is only available for applicants in AZ, & CA

HVAC– Certificate

Graduates earn a Certificate of Completion. This program is only available for applicants in AZ, & CA

LVN to ADN – Associate

Graduates earn an Associate of Science degree. Upon completion of the California Board of Registered Nursing approved program, the students are prepared to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN)*.

Maintenance Technician– Certificate

Graduates earn a Certificate of Completion. This program is only available for applicants in AZ.

Massage Therapy– Certificate

Graduates earn a Certificate of Completion. The Massage Therapy program at all locations prepares students for the Massage and Bodywork Licensing Exam (MBLEX)* through the Federation of State Massage Therapy Boards (FSMTB). In order to obtain CAMTC Certification as a Certified Massage Therapist, an applicant shall apply to CAMTC. This program is only available for applicants in AZ, CA, & ID.



Medical Assisting– Certificate

Graduates earn a Certificate of Completion. Graduates of the Medical Assisting program at all locations including online are eligible to sit for the National Healthcareer Association (NHA) Certified Clinical Medical Assistant (CCMA) exam*. Graduates at all locations except online are eligible to sit for the national certification exam to attain the Registered Medical Assistant (RMA) credential*. Graduates of the program at all campuses except online are eligible to sit for the national exam to attain the Certified Medical Assistant (CMA) credential*. This program is only available for applicants in AZ, CA, ID, NV, NM, OR, & WA.

Medical Office Administration – Certificate

Graduates earn a Certificate of Completion. Within the State of California, graduates of the Medical Office Administration program are eligible to sit for the National Certified Medical Office Assistant (NCMOA) exam or the National Certified Insurance & Coding Specialist (NCIS) exam offered by the National Center for Competency Testing (NCCT).* This program is only available for applicants in AZ & CA.

Nursing Bridge- Associate (Science Emphasis)

Graduates earn an Associate of Science degree. Graduates of the Nursing Bridge program earn an Associate of Science degree and are prepared to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN)*. This program is only available for applicants in CA.

Pharmacy Technology– Certificate

Graduates are eligible and prepared to sit for the national certification exam through either the National Healthcare Association (NHA) which administers the EXCPT exam or the Pharmacy Technician Certification Board (PTCB) which administers the CPhT exam. This program is only available for applicants in AZ, CA, ID, NM, & WA.

Phlebotomy– Certificate

Graduates earn a Certificate of Completion. The Phlebotomy Technician course prepares students to sit for the National Healthcareer Association Phlebotomy Technician Certification (CPT) exam*. This program is only available for applicants in NV.

Physical Therapy Technology – Certificate

Graduates earn a Certificate of Completion. This program is only available for applicants in AZ.

Physical Therapist Assistant – Associate

Graduates earn an Associate of Science degree. Students who successfully complete the Physical Therapist Assistant program are eligible to take the National Physical Therapy Examination (NPTE) for PTAs*. To work as a physical therapist assistant in California, graduates must also pass the California Law Examination (CLE), which relates to the practice of physical therapy. This program is only available for applicants in CA & NV.

Practical Nursing - Associate (Science Emphasis)



Graduates earn an Associate of Science degree. The program's combined academic and clinical training prepares students to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses (NCLEX-PN)*. This program is only available for applicants in ID & NV.

Registered Nursing - Certificate

Graduates earn a Certificate of Completion. Graduates earn an Associate of Science degree. The program's combined academic and clinical training prepares students to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Practical Nurses (NCLEX-RN)*. This program is only available for applicants in CA.

Registered Nursing – Associate

Graduates earn an Associate of Science degree. Graduates are eligible to apply to the California Board of Registered Nursing to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN)*. This program is only available for applicants in CA.

Registered Nursing – LVN to RN Bridge – Associate

Graduates earn an Associate of Science degree. Graduates are eligible to apply to the California Board of Registered Nursing to take the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN)*. This program is only available for applicants in CA.

Respiratory Care – Associate

Graduates earn an Associate of Science degree. Students who successfully complete the Respiratory Care program are eligible for the National Board for Respiratory Care (NBRC) credentialing exams, which include the Therapist Multiple-Choice (TMC) exam and the Clinical Simulation Examination (CSE)*. This program is only available for applicants in AZ, CA, & NV.

Respiratory Therapy – Associate

Graduates earn an Associate of Science degree. Students who successfully complete the Respiratory Therapy program are eligible for the National Board for Respiratory Care (NBRC) credentialing exams, which include the Therapist Multiple-Choice (TMC) exam and the Clinical Simulation Examination (CSE)*. This program is only available for applicants in AZ, CA, & NV.

Surgical Technology – Associate

Graduates earn an Associate of Science degree. Students who successfully complete the Surgical Technology program are eligible for the Certification of Surgical Technologists (CST) through the National Board for Surgical Technology and Surgical Assisting (NBSTSA)*. This program is only available for applicants in AZ & CA.

Veterinary Assistant – Certificate

Graduates earn a Certificate of Completion
